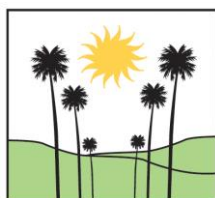

Discussion and possible action:  
From Stakeholder Luis Sanchez---These are 2 recommendations you may or may not have time to consider:
  - a) send a letter of support for the Summer Night Lights program at El Sereno RC to city representative and departments. At any given moment the city can decide to have the program at another park instead of El Sereno. It is NOT guaranteed the program will continue at the El Sereno RC in perpetuity.  
On a nightly basis hundreds of people (adults, kids, families) go to the park to enjoy the free food, movies, activities, games and FREE competitive sports leagues during the summer.
  - b) send a letter of support to the Kaiser Permanente Foundation for offering scholarships so that kids at Alatorre pool at NO cost can take swimming lessons, be on the swim team, dive team, or play water polo etc. It is NOT guaranteed the Kaiser scholarships will continue at Richard Alatorre pool in perpetuity. At any moment they can decrease the number of scholarships offered.  
  
Many kids learn to swim and compete in aquatic sports that probably would not otherwise. Potential drownings are prevented when kids learn to swim

*The Board may reconsider and amend its action on items listed on the agenda if that reconsideration takes place immediately following the original action or at the next regular meeting. The Board, on either of these two occasions, shall: (1) Make a Motion for Reconsideration and, if approved, (2) hear the matter and take action. If the motion to reconsider and action is to be scheduled at the next regular meeting following the original action, then two items shall be placed on the agenda for that meeting: (1) a Motion for Reconsideration on the described matter and (2) a Proposed Action should the motion to reconsider be approved. If a motion for reconsideration is not made on the date the action was taken, then a Board member on the prevailing side of the action must submit a memorandum to the Secretary identifying the matter to be reconsidered and a brief description of the reason(s) for requesting reconsideration at the next regular meeting. The aforesaid shall all be in compliance with the Brown Act.*
